<b>WHAT</b>	<b>Collect unwanted household hazardous waste</b>

**THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR RESIDENTS! (100-pound limit)**

This program is for residential waste ONLY. Federal regulations do NOT allow commercial hazardous waste to be mixed with household hazardous wastes. Businesses or agencies that generate less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste per month and meet other criteria are eligible to participate with US Ecology AK.

**DO NOT PUT THEM IN YOUR TRASH — DO NOT MIX ITEMS**  
**DO NOT BRING the following: explosives, flares, business waste, medical waste, empty containers, asbestos, or radioactive wastes.**

## WHAT TO BRING

**ITEMS TO BRING:** Floor care products, furniture polish, metal polish, bug sprays, automatic transmission fluid, car batteries, brake fluid, car wax, diesel fuel, used oils, cutting glue, paint, paint brush cleaner, thinner & stripper, turpentine, varnish, wood preservative, primer, fungicide, herbicide, insecticide, rodent poison, weed killer, fiberglass epoxy, gun cleaning solvents, photographic chemicals.

**PLEASE REMEMBER:**

- \* Bring your household hazardous waste in the original containers. If you use a different container, clearly label it. And only use containers you can part with.
- \* Keep containers from tipping or leaking while transporting your waste to the collection site.
- \* If the container is leaking, enclose it in another container.
- \* Keep the material in a secure place for transport in your vehicle and keep it away/out of reach from children and pets.
- \* Separate paint from other material.
- \* Don't mix different types of household wastes.
- \* There is a 100-pound limit for residential household hazardous waste.
