KODIAK, ALASKA, FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: September 24, 2021

The Kodiak Emergency Operations Center has received new COVID-19 case information for the Kodiak Island Borough.

Twelve (12) new cases have been reported for the Kodiak Island Borough.

- One (1) case was tested on 9/10/21
 - This case is travel related
- Two (2) cases were tested on 9/21/21
 - One (1) case is a close contact of a previously reported case
 - One (1) case is classified as community spread
- Seven (7) cases were tested on 9/23/21
 - One (1) case is travel related
 - One (1) case is a close contact of a previously reported case
 - Five (5) cases are classified as community spread
- Two (2) cases were tested on 9/24/21
 - One (1) case is a close contact of a previously reported case
 - One (1) case is classified as community spread

The total case count associated with the Kodiak Island Borough is now one thousand, nine hundred and ninety-five (1995) with two hundred and seventeen (217) cases currently classified as active. There have been eighty (80) local hospitalizations associated with COVID-19, there are three (3) active cases currently hospitalized in Kodiak. Seven (7) deaths associated with COVID-19 have been officially reported for the Kodiak Island Borough.
